SUBJECT: Brigade Policy Memorandum 9 - Prevention of Sexual Assault Policy

1. References.

- a. AR 600-20, Army Command Policy, 11 February 2009.
- b. DoDi 6495.02, Department of Defense Instruction, 28 March 2013.

2. Purpose. Provide command policy for compliance, commitment to, and education of the prevention of sexual assault within this brigade.

3. In accordance with AR 600-20 Chapter 8-2 a., sexual assault is a criminal offense that has no place in the Army. It degrades mission readiness by devastating the Army's ability to work effectively as a team. Every Soldier who is aware of a sexual assault should immediately (within 24 hours) report the incident. Sexual assault is incompatible with Army values and punishable under the UCMJ and other Federal and local civilian laws. I want to make it perfectly clear to all personnel that sexual assault will not be tolerated within this brigade. It is unacceptable behavior. In any environment, our conduct towards others must be professional and proper at all times.

4. We will maximize training, education, and awareness to minimize the incidence of sexual assault and to promote the sensitive handling of victims of sexual assault. We will hold those who commit sexual assault offenses accountable while providing the victims a confidential avenue for reporting.

5. The Brigade Sexual Assault Response Coordinator (SARC) is Mr. Kevin Watson at 910-224-5304 (cell) and the Brigade Victim Advocate is Mrs. Valerie Stockton at 910-224-2471 (cell). The SARC and VA are available to advise victims 24/7 on resources and reporting options (restricted and unrestricted) in accordance with restricted reporting policy, applicable privileged communications, and all applicable Federal, DoD, and Service privacy laws and regulations.
